1. NON-RESOLUTION BOARD ITEMS

President Scott Savage called the meeting to order at 8:31 a.m.

Mr. Scott Savage led the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

Mr. Fritz Byers made a motion to approve the consent agenda, including the disposition of the minutes for the regular Board meeting held on July 27, 2022. This motion was seconded by Ms. Molly Luetke and approved.

Mr. Byers introduced Ms. Amy Natyshak, new legal counsel for Metroparks Toledo. He went on to share that she graciously agreed to become a member of our team as we move into a new era within the agency. Mr. Byers stated that she was exactly the right person for our grand vision regarding our public agency activity, initially in

handling human resources and labor issues, specifically labor negotiations. Metroparks Toledo's engagement in labor negotiations was rapid, collective, and proved to illustrate overall great teamwork. He went on to share that this was a good time for the agency to consider expanding her role with Metroparks Toledo operations. Ms. Natyshak is a person of great skill, immaculate judgement, highest conceivable ethics, an excellent addition to the team.

3. CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS FROM DIRECTOR AND EMPLOYEES OF THE PARK DISTRICT FOR REVIEW

A. Recognition of Metroparks Toledo Staff Serving 25+ Years – Dave Zenk, Executive Director

Mr. Savage introduced Mr. Dave Zenk to recognize Metroparks Toledo staff members who have served 25+ years of their excellent work for the agency. Mr. Savage went to share that these staff members are able to deliver on the promises that Metroparks Toledo has made through the years, and thanked them from the bottom of his heart. Mr. Zenk additional shared that he is beyond grateful for all of their years of service and went on to share about all the work each of them have contributed to the district. Mr. Savage stated each one of them are carrying on the Metroparks Toledo culture to our younger leaders and recognized that this is a big responsibility. Incoming staff need mentorship and understand "The Metropark Way" and he thanked each of them for all of the work that they continue to do. Mr. Byers shared that in keeping with this spirit, any public entity has challenges in facing the expectations of the community, including the speed with which Metroparks Toledo faces new challenges in how we respond to the accountability as steward for our community. He went on to share that the tenure of these staff are flexible enough to accept these challenges, and that the successes the agency has had to date, really rest on all of you as individuals and is grateful for each of them.

B. Conservation and Management – Jay Wright, Director of Conservation Science

Mr. Tim Schetter introduced Mr. Jay Wright, who is the new Metroparks Toledo Director of Conservation Science. Mr. Wright brings a wide range of research capabilities from across the globe and Metroparks Toledo was lucky enough to have him join the team. His main focus will be to drive our adaptive research.

Mr. Wright reviewed updates on three specific areas of research at Metroparks Toledo; cattle grazing, oak wilt management, and avian monitoring programs.

Cattle Grazing

Mr. Wright shared that Cows are selective grazers with diets similar to bison; managing cows can mimic natural grazing disturbance. The primary goals for this project are to improve ground-nesting bird and pollinator habitat, by increasing structural heterogeneity and plant diversity, reducing "invasive" and woody cover, and creating bare patches.

After weekly bird surveys from May through July, findings show that the most common breeders in the grazed area are early successional generalists. The early results of monthly vegetation surveys are showing increased structural heterogeneity with some dense areas remaining, as well as a mix of short and tall grass. Additionally, overall grass cover has decreased, bare ground has slightly increased, ferns have slightly decreased and goldenrod/woody cover has remained the same.

Mr. Wright explained that future grazing management plans are to rest the south parkway meadow for a year while continuing to monitor, add a larger grazing meadow in need of management, consult with prairie experts and work with researchers to study and adapt grazing strategies.

Oak Wilt Management

Mr. Wright shared that there are several ways to manage oak wilt depending on the severity of disease outbreaks.

Unfortunately, about 200 trees have likely been infected throughout the Oak Openings region properties each year since 2020. The management of this is to monitor and remove infected trees, and trench around infected areas to prevent below-ground spread; however, trenching equipment is not currently available. Metroparks Toledo hosted Dr. Jennifer Juzwik who is an expert in this field to discuss other options in treating this disease.

Overall, the changes in the Oak Wilt management plan includes continuing to monitor and remove in previous oak wilt areas, while also removing maples to encourage oak regeneration. Mr. Wright went on to share that we will begin early detection/rapid response management in new areas by adding an additional flight scheduled earlier in July.

Avian Monitoring Plan

Mr. Wright explained that the goals for this plan include:

- Tracking changes in species use of parks over time
- Associating habitats and management practices with species presence and abundance
- Monitoring population status of state-listed species
- Contributing to regional and national databases
- Using indicator species to assess attainment status

The monitoring program will encompass all four seasons, and bird survey locations will be distributed across all major habitat types in every park. Wherever possible, survey locations will be overlaid with existing plant monitoring plots to associate vegetation characteristics with bird species composition.

Ms. Luetke stated that this information was informative and thanked him for presenting. Additionally she shared that Mr. Schetter will be giving a Tedx Talk on September 15, 2022.

Mr. Byers shared that while we've had various presentations in the past, this is a reminder of why Metroparks Toledo exists and that the board has reshaped the vision to focus more on conservation. He went on to state that the Board of Park Commissioners are very happy to have him with Metroparks Toledo along with his ability to understand the complexity of nature and being able to respond proactively to nature to prevent any future erosion.

C. Treasurer's Report - Matt Cleland, Chief Financial Officer/Treasurer

Mr. Matt Cleland stated that everything is trending as expected. He mentioned that one item to note was a larger shift in salaries based on the successful outcome to negotiations and providing retroactive payments.

The Then and Now has a couple of Lathrop payments; however an appropriations will be performed so that we can get ahead of this in the future.

Mr. Byers inquired about the expenditures in materials and supplies contract services, running behind, function of timing? Mr. Cleland shared that yes, timing is a primary factor, but tends to fall within budget holders. As we get towards to the end of the budget year, budget holders determine what projects can be placed on hold or what needs to get done.

Mr. Byers shared that this is outside of our typical experiences and applauds Metroparks Toledo for focusing on our clean, safe, natural experiences by contracting with outside services. He went on to state that he supports the thinking of this decision as this is one of the real wow factors for the downtown park.

Mr. Dalton inquired is if we will be training our own staff through this process. Mr. Matt Killam responded that is the plan so that we can learn best practices and eventually have our own staff trained to take over the operations of this.

1. Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – General Fund as of 08/31/2022

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of the General Fund budgeted revenues, expenditures and transfers compared to actual revenues, expenditures and transfers by month as well as year-end. The approved 2022 general operating fund budget and actual cash basis revenues, expenditures and transfers are represented. Year to date budget distribution is based upon a 12 month proration with the exception of salaries and fringe benefits. Salary and fringe benefit budget distribution is based upon a proration of 26 pay dates. (See Appended Statement – Attachment A).

<u>Current State</u>: Interest revenue is trending above budget due to the significant rate increases since the 2022 Budget was established. Other revenue is greater than budgeted due to one-time property tax refunds. Year to date fringe benefits in August are below expected amount because the August invoice posted on September 2, 2022.

2. Receipts, Disbursements and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – All Funds as of 08/31/2022

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of annual budgeted receipts and disbursements compared to cash basis actuals as of month end. The General, Education/Programming and Capital Construction funds are presented as individual columns. The "Grant Funds", "Land Acquisition/Development" and "All Other Funds" columns are each summaries of multiple funds. The far right column is a total of all funds. General fund budget and actual numbers presented in this report are consistent with those presented in the report listed above. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment B).

<u>Current State</u>: All Funds BVA is trending as expected through the month of August. We will be monitoring Fund 204 salary expenses through the end of the year.

3. Fund Advances Report – All Funds as of 08/31/2022

<u>Description</u>: This is a report of inter-fund, Board approved advances activity. Advances are made to support reimbursement grants and activities that would otherwise result in negative fund balances. Advances are returned following the receipt of grant reimbursement revenue.

DESCRIPTION:

Sealed proposals for bidding on district-wide tree maintenance and removal were received Friday, September 16, 2022. One bid was received from T & J Excavating and Tree Removal, LLC of Holland, and the only bidder.

The Scope of Work consists of maintenance and removal of hazardous and damaged trees in areas/situations where it is deemed unsafe for park district employees to perform the work. Work is expected to commence this fall, continuing throughout the year as necessary. The total cost of tree maintenance contracting is anticipated not to exceed the annual budget of \$60,000.00 with a three-year contract amount of \$180,000.00.

The contract allows Metroparks the option to extend the contract term two additional years for an overall not-to-exceed amount of \$300,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a three-year service contract with T & J Excavating and Tree Removal, LLC not-to-exceed \$180,000.00 (\$60,000.00 per year for three years) with an option of two additional years for an additional \$120,000.00) for an overall not-to-exceed amount of \$300,000.00.

At the September 22, 2021 regular meeting of the Board, Resolution 49-21 was duly adopted approving a contract for Construction Manager At-Risk Services (CMAR) with Kokosing Construction Company, Inc. for Glass City Riverwalk preconstruction services. Now that Project Plans and Specifications are substantially complete, the CMAR has developed a final construction cost estimate used to arrive at a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for all construction work which will serve as the culmination of the overall GMP for the full project for a final Glass City Riverwalk Contract amount of \$50,885,792.00. This GMP figure was reconciled by Stanton, Metropark's Independent Cost Estimator (ICE) consultant, and concurrence received by both ODOT and FHWA.

The transformative Glass City Riverwalk GMP Scope of Work consists of multi-use paths and numerous pocket-park areas with amenities. Amenities include lawns, landscape beds and floating wetland habitat-islands, river access step-down areas, boardwalks and overlooks, benches and swings, transient boat docks, kayak share and launch, seawalls, railings, bridges, shade structures, a restroom and lighting along Maumee River frontage in downtown Toledo and International Park.

The total cost of construction contracting is anticipated to be \$55,500,000.00 which includes the construction contract (\$50,885,792.00), with the remainder reserved as Owner contingency (\$4,614,208.00). Metroparks will be reimbursed for eighty percent (80%) of construction costs up to \$21,516,480.00 from federal Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) funds made possible through a grant from Toledo Metropolitan Council of Governments (TMACOG), making Metroparks' total liability \$33,983,520.00.

It is anticipated that a construction administration and quality assurance testing contract in support of the project will similarly be brought before the Board for consideration in October, 2022. Substantial completion for the total project is anticipated by November, 2025.
