1. NON-RESOLUTION BOARD ITEMS

President Scott Savage called the meeting to order at 8:39 a.m.

Mr. Scott Savage led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Savage introduced Metroparks Toledo Ranger Michael Makras and our newest addition, Timber. Ranger Makras shared that Timber, a Goldador, has joined the Ranger Department and will be trained to assist with officer wellness and public outreach, and will be available to Rangers and staff at the park system as well as other agencies during critical incidents.

2. CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

Mr. Fritz Byers made a motion for the disposition of the minutes for the regular Board meeting held on November

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15, 2023 and the consent agenda for the meeting on December 20, 2023. This motion was seconded by Mrs. Lera Doneghy and approved.

3. CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS FROM DIRECTOR AND EMPLOYEES OF THE PARK DISTRICT FOR REVIEW

A. Cityworks Implementation – Alex Cook, Maintenance and Forecast Coordinator

Mr. Cook began the presentation by explaining the overarching goals for successful asset management. Currently we use three separate software applications to track asset management; however, as the agency continues to grow, there was a need to have these programs integrated along with inclusion of a mapping feature to better track agency-wide data.

Cityworks will be able to update and track major maintenance, assist operations in overall tracking, map functionality and assist with overall budgeting and internal task communication.

Mr. Cook went on to share that every licensed user within Cityworks will be able to design their own dashboard and data points that best fits their needs. Within the dashboard, a user can pull up a specific work order to review pertinent information as well as all items that may need to be addressed. The system also allows the user to upload attachments pertaining to those tasks, i.e., a receipt for anything paid toward that particular item.

This software will also allow Metroparks Toledo to ensure accountability for internal communications, adhere to strategic planning as well as maintaining promises kept to our community. Additionally, this software allows for growth by adding on other software components, i.e., store room, which is the ability to track materials.

Right now Mr. Cook shared that we're in the final stages by adding data and upon rollout, will adapt to each departments' needs for training and establish uniform usage rules for proper program cohesion. The plan is to have operations, rangers and planning and capital projects begin with utilizing the software.

Mr. Byers stated that this is so impressive and allows for such attention to detail. He went on to share that almost invariably, much of all the work staff do is out of sight and behind the scenes. This illustrates what Metroparks Toledo does so well, abiding by our Mission, and continuing to be great stewards for our constituents. He went on to share that our commitment to be transparent and excellent stewards is why we do what we do in making certain investments. This data allows us to answer those questions clearly. My Byers thanked Mr. Cook and his team for all that you do.

B. Treasurer's Report – Matt Cleland, CFO/Treasurer

Mr. Matt Cleland stated that we're still not done with 2023; however, expenses are still trending very close to the budget which is evidence of the volume of work that is happening. Mr. Byers shared that in his observation, it is notable how precisely Mr. Cleland and his team have budgeted, including unexpected items throughout the year, and to see revenue is above budget and expenses below budget. He went on to state this allows us to have the confidence to move forward, make plans and continue to dream because of the solid foundation that has been established.

Mr. Byers shared that every month we seem to hear about a new initiative and/or expansion to continue sharing our resources with our people. To the outside, this appears that it goes really well, which it does, because internally the groundwork has be taken care of so well. He went on to state that the services we receive from Ms. Amy Natyshak and her team are not only an example of that, but are very effective and highly efficient as well. With Metroparks Toledo's continued expansions, these services are needed and appreciated.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

C. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms., Luetke:

Resolution No. 87-23 – Amendment to Board Resolution No. 98-22, "Issuance of Super Blanket Purchase Orders for 2023 Recycling and Waste Disposal Services"

Mr. Cleland stated we continue to ensure that we do not go over our approved amount.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

D. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mrs. Doneghy:

Resolution No. 88-23 – Approval of Supplement and Amendment of the 2023 Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations Measure

Mr. Cleland shared that as the buckeye fund expenses come in, we make the appropriations as needed from a contingency account and then supplement the budget to make the contingency account whole. Fund 401 appropriations support administrative expenses related to land acquisitions.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

E. Mrs. Doneghy offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 89-23 – Approval of Final Amendment and Supplement of the 2023 Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations Measure

Mr. Cleland shared that this is our opportunity to realign our 2023 budget to actual. Mr. Savage noted that almost \$97 million in appropriations equates to the incredible amount of work performed quietly by our staff. He went to share that this is simply ground breaking for Metroparks Toledo.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

F. Mr. Byers offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 90-23 – Approve of Return of Advances from Funds 256, 257, and 258 to General Fund

Mr. Cleland stated that advances are from our general fund to our other funds to prevent negative fund balances. When revenues are received the advanced funds are returned to the general fund.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

G. Ms. Luetke offered and moved for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mrs. Doneghy:

Resolution No. 91-23 – Approval of General Fund Advance

Mr. Savage shared that our grant funding is a way to diversify our funding, and extended congratulations to Mr. Allen Gallant and his team for his efforts and continued efforts to pursue, with vigor, opportunities to do what we'd like to do. He went on to share that this allows us to not solely rely on the tax payers within Lucas County and helps to shoulder the burden.

H. Mrs. Doneghy offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Resolution No. 92-23 – 2024 Annual Appropriation Measure

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

Mr. Byers shared that learning more about the budgeting process, there's a lot that goes on behind the scenes, thank you to Mr. Cleland and his team for their continued due diligence and hard work. Mr. Savage also stated that in the spirit of transparency, all levels of detail are available online and accessibly by anyone.

I. Mr. Byers offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 93-23 – Establish Use and Amount of Blanket Purchase Orders for 2024

Mr. Cleland stated that this number has been in place for five years and stands at \$50,000.

Mr. Cleland stated that there is a 9% increase in premium, which is in line with the current market. He went on to state that we enjoy this benefit through Lucas County.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

M. Mrs. Doneghy offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mr. Byers:

Mr. Cleland shared that there is a 20% increase, which is the evidence of the work that's being done; 15% of that is for new facilities and activities. Additionally, this is essentially the result of inflation and increased facility values rather than claims experience.

 - Dr. Schetter stated that this property falls within the footprint for Manhattan Marsh, and is appreciative for Get Outside Yourself. Your Clean, Safe, Natural Metroparks 10

the Lucas County Land Bank who helped to facilitate the purchase.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

Resolution No. 107-23 – Ratification of Land Purchase: 5150 Whitehouse Spencer Road

Dr. Schetter shared that this is the most remarkable properties for ecological diversity and rivals any natural areas within Oak Openings Preserve. While it took some time due to estate settlements in probate, it was definitely well worth the wait. He went on to share that 75% of the purchase price was covered by Clean Ohio Fund and then an anonymous donor covered the remaining 25%. Mr. Savage shared that this is just excellent.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

X. Ms. Luetke offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mrs. Doneghy:

Resolution No. 108-23 – Approval of Lease Agreement

Dr. Schetter stated that in keeping with the original purchase agreement, Keil and Sons continue to farm the land until we're ready to do something with the land. This allows us to maintain the property and reduces our maintenance costs. This lease agreement allows Metroparks Toledo to continue to renew until we decide further.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

Y. Mr. Byers offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Resolution No. 109-23 – Contract Approval, Timber Sale, Oak Openings Preserve Metropark

Dr. Schetter shared that this in continuation of our timber management plans several years ago. The Pines are iconic, planted in the 1930s-1970s; unfortunately, no plan has taken place to manage them and they are nearing the end of their lives. Currently, we've abandoned timber stand improvements deciding that they either stay or they get removed. He went on to state that we're still maintaining as best we can, especially the area known as the "The Spot." During this process, once the 75 acres have been removed, implementation will take place for them to be restored. Ms. LaRae Sprow shared that through the course of restoration process, there will be careful action taken near the areas identified as native species and high quality life. The entire restoration process will take approximately two years to complete.

Mrs. Doneghy inquired if we'll be educating the public the reason behind this process. Dr. Schetter shared that there will be displays in the Windows of Wildlife; additionally, we'll be offering public tours on the weekends to share the purpose of the work and illustrate what's going on.

Mr. Byers stated that Dr. Schetter's depth and breadth of his knowledge in the importance of ecological preservation with our natural research is second-to-none. He went on to share that there's such an incredible amount of knowledge and science based decisions and thanked Dr. Schetter and his team for their due diligence.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the Get Outside Yourself. Your Clean. Safe. Natural Metroparks 11 appendix to these minutes.

Z. Ms. Luetke offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Mrs. Doneghy:

Resolution No. 110-23 – Contract Approval, Oak Openings Preserve Tree Removal, Swanton Township, Lucas County, Ohio

Mr. Savage recognized Dr. Schetter, Ms. Sprow, Ms. Menard and Mr. Lawrence Brewer who all collaborated with Mr. Scott Abella on their latest research document on controlled burns and the research around that. He went to congratulate them all of for all the research performed through these past 34 years.

He went on to share that the operations staff took notice of this and encouraged that something needed to be done with this playground.

Mr. Savage passed along to Ms. Ally Effler and the Foundation Board his gratitude for their assistance.

After discussion and upon unanimous vote the resolution was declared duly adopted and recorded in the appendix to these minutes.

BB. Mr. Byers offered to move and amend for adoption of the following resolution, with a second by Ms. Luetke:

Mr. Doug Parish shared that this is for fire protection for the Cannaley Treehouse Village.

5. BOARD INITIATED TOPICS AND DISCUSSION

Mr. Savage introduced special guest. Mr. Calvin Brown. Mr. Brown congratulated Metroparks Toledo on winning the top buyer award for the Ohio Minority Supplier Diversity Development Council. Mr. Savage shared that this award was not only a first for Northwest Ohio, but also as a public entity recipient. He went on to thank Mrs. Felica Clark with all of her work. Mr. Zenk stated that when Metroparks Toledo was challenged with updating our Vision statement, we asked ourselves, what does success look like? One strong component was incorporating our inclusion ability and this award demonstrates a real step forward in this approach. He went on to share that our diversity spend affected all areas of our agency and included monthly meetings to develop networking and building relationships in this space. Ms. Clark organized this entire process which has also helped to shift our focus in this space.

Mr. Zenk noted that this is potentially the record number of resolutions within the past 10 years. Additionally, we went on to recognize the Metroparks Toledo Foundation. They too set a record, the amount of funds transferred back to Metroparks Toledo which was over \$2M. He went on to thank them and shared that they are a talented board with the support of very talented team.

Lastly, Mr. Zenk shared that at 10:30am, Ohio Department of Natural Resources Director Mary Mertz will be arriving for the Blue Creek Glad Declaration.

With no further business or action to be taken, Mrs. Doneghy made a motion to adjourn the Board meeting at 9:58 a.m., which was seconded by Mr. Byers and approved.

1. Revenues, Expenditures and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – General Fund as of 12/31/2023

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of the General Fund budgeted revenues, expenditures and transfers compared to actual revenues, expenditures and transfers by month as well as year-end. The approved 2023 general operating fund budget and actual cash basis revenues, expenditures and transfers are represented. Year to date budget distribution is based upon a 12 month proration with the exception of salaries and fringe benefits. Salary and fringe benefit budget distribution is based upon a proration of 26 pay dates. (See Appended Statement – Attachment A).

<u>Current State</u>: Revenue for The Ribbon was deposited after year-end causing sales revenue to fall short of projection. Total revenue for the year was one percent above projection.

A diligent effort to be conservative with year-end spending kept expenses five percent within budget. A review of budget versus actual reports from the past indicates this is the narrowest year-end variance to date.

2. Receipts, Disbursements and Changes in Fund Balances – Budget vs. Actual – All Funds as of 12/31/2023

<u>Description</u>: This report is a comparison of annual budgeted receipts and disbursements compared to cash basis actuals as of month end. The General, Education/Programming, and Debt Service funds are presented as individual columns. The Grant Funds, Land Acquisition/Development, Capital Construction and All Other Funds columns are each summaries of multiple funds. The far right column is a total of all funds. General fund budget and actual numbers presented in this report are consistent with those presented in the report listed above. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment B).

<u>Current State</u>: The programming fund required similar diligence to that of the general fund to finish the year with a positive fund balance.

3. Fund Advances Report – All Funds as of 12/31/2023

<u>Description</u>: This is a report of inter-fund, Board approved advances activity. Advances are made to support reimbursement grants and activities that would otherwise result in negative fund balances. Advances are returned following the receipt of grant reimbursement revenue.

5. Credit Card Account Review as of 12/31/2023

Description: Per Ohio Revised Code 1545.072 the credit card compliance officer must review the number of cards and accounts issued, the number of active cards and accounts issued, the cards' and accounts' expiration dates, and the cards' and accounts' credit limits and report this information to the board at least quarterly. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment D)

<u>Current State</u>: Josh Brenwell, Credit Card Compliance Officer, has reviewed the attached report and compared it with credit card statements to confirm the accuracy of information provided.

No rewards have been received based on the use of the park district's credit card account for 2023.

6. Investment Ledger as of 12/31/2023

<u>Description</u>: This report is a listing of the Park District's current investment holdings. Current investments are allowable per the Ohio Revised Code and are laddered over a 5-year period. (See Appended Statement -- Attachment E).

<u>Current State</u>: One government security matured with proceeds reinvested in another. One certificate of deposit was purchased with money market funds.

7. Then and Now Report for the month ended 12/31/2023

<u>Description</u>: The Ohio Revised Code (ORC) requires fiscal certification indicating that amounts required for purchases, obligations, contracts, etc. have been lawfully appropriated and are in the treasury or in the process of collection to the credit of an appropriate fund free from any previous encumbrances. Then and now is a certification by the Board that funds were available when an obligation was made (then) and at the time of certification (now) for obligations made prior to certification. DESCRIPTION:

The 2024 Annual Appropriations Measure was approved by the Board at the December 2023 Board Meeting. Additional supplements to the 2024 Certificate of Estimated Resources and Appropriations Measure are needed to address supplements as summarized below. The affected line item appropriations and Certificate of Estimated Resources are attached.

The affected funds are as follows:

Fund 200 – Land Acquisition Levy

Decrease appropriations in the amount of \$3,695 to limit 2024 appropriations to the amount of the beginning of year fund balance. This decrease brings the total of appropriations in fund 202 to \$5,440.

Fund 202 – Buckeye

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$4,012,732 for various donation supported initiatives. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 202 to \$4,312,732.

Fund 256 - USEPA Auduban Island

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$3,236,304 to support restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 256 to \$12,598,510.

Fund 256 - USEPA Blue Creek/Neis Ditch

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$829,003 to support restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 256 to \$13,427,513.

Fund 256 - Ducks Unlimited/NOAA Howard Marsh Phase 2

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$78,343 to support water quality. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 256 to \$13,505,856.

<u>Fund 256 - United States Fish and Wildlife Service -TNC, Blazing Brighter: Blazing Star</u> Borer Moth Habitat Restoration in the Oak Openings, Phase II

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$75,000 to support restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 256 to \$13,580,856.

<u>Fund 257 - OPWC Clean Ohio Fund - Oak Openings Corridor: Frankfort Tract</u> CLPAA

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$40,960 to support land acquisition and restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 257 to \$1,333,459.

Fund 257 - Oak Openings Reed Road Expansion CLQAB

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$4,718 to support land acquisition and restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 257 to \$1,338,177.

Fund 257 OPWC Clean Ohio Oak Openings Corridor: Waterville-Swanton Tract CLQAC

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$650,027 to support land acquisition and restoration. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 257 to \$1,988,204.

Fund 400 - Capital Construction

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$869,849 to support capital construction and major maintenance. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 401 to \$2,860,530.

Fund 401 – Land Development

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$460,270 to support land acquisition. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 401 to \$560,270.

Fund 404 - Glass City Riverwalk

Increase appropriations in the amount of \$1,407,559 to support land acquisition. This increase brings the total of appropriations in fund 401 to \$9,583,617.

DESCRIPTION:

The Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity, or RAISE Discretionary Grant program, provides an opportunity for the DOT to invest in road, rail, transit and port projects that promise to achieve national objectives with significant local or regional impact. The program was previously known as the Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development (BUILD) and Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Discretionary Grants.

RAISE projects are reviewed and evaluated on statutory criteria of safety, environmental sustainability, quality of life, mobility and community connectivity, economic competitiveness and opportunity including tourism, state of good repair, partnership and collaboration, and innovation. As was the case in previous years, the DOT is encouraging applicants to consider how their projects can address climate change, ensure racial equity, and remove barriers to opportunity. DOT also intends to use the RAISE program to support lowering costs for household budgets, wealth creation and the creation of good-paying jobs with the free and fair choice to join a union, the incorporation of strong labor standards, and training and placement programs, especially registered apprenticeships.

The maximum grant award is \$25 million, and projects in urban areas are required to provide at least 20% match.

Approve staff to submit an application for funding through the Department of Transportation.
